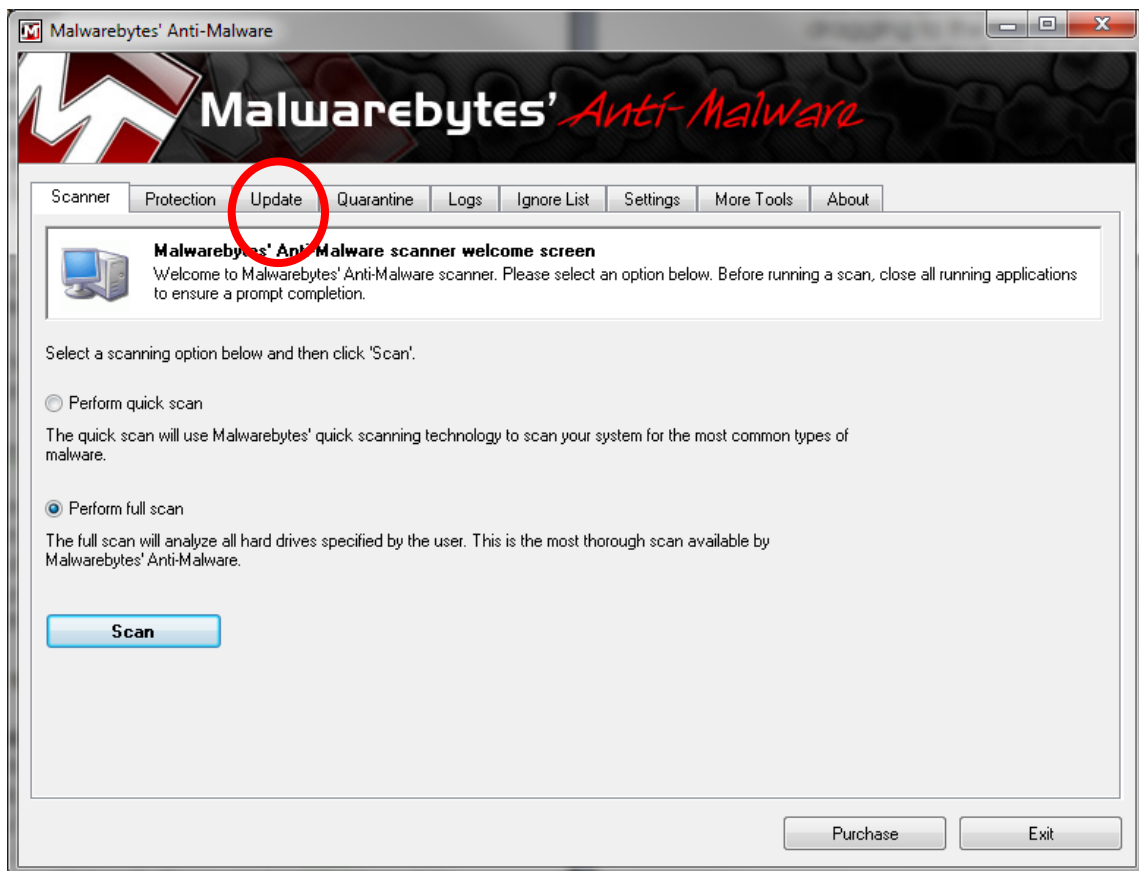


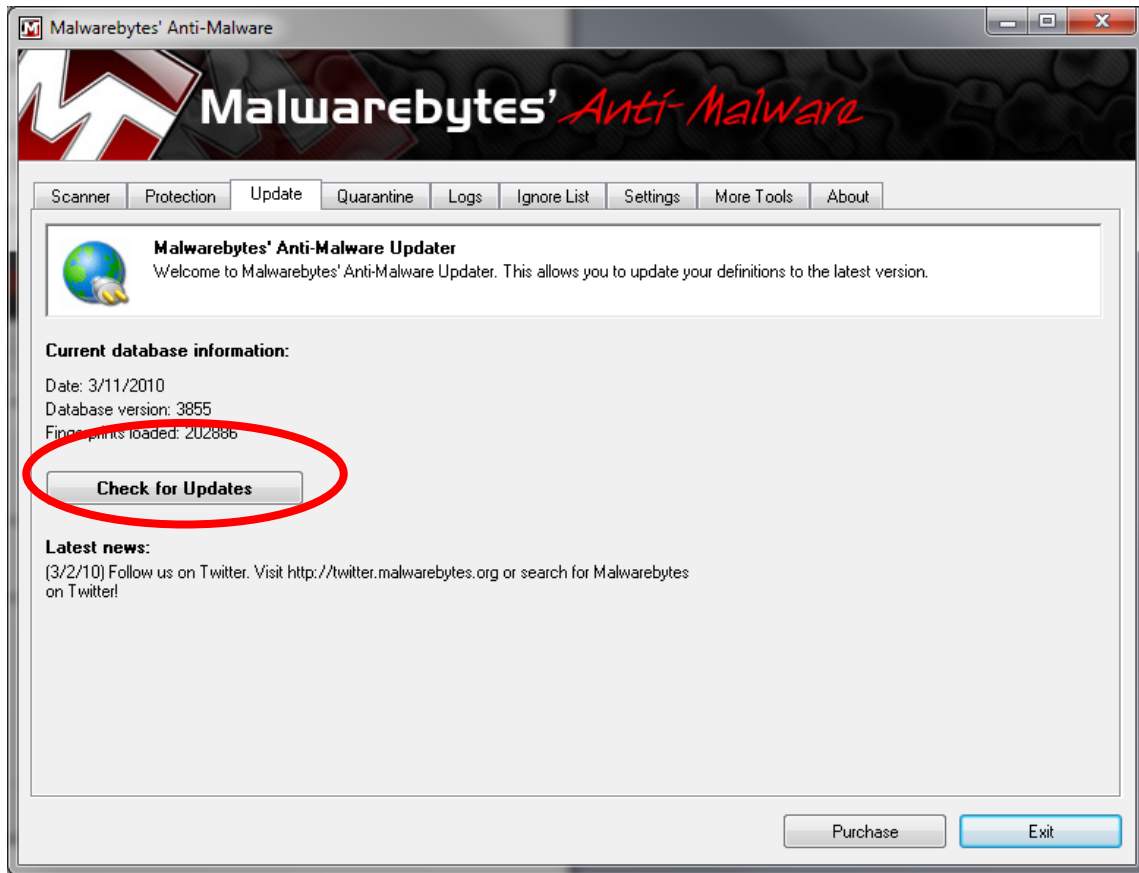
Using MalwareBytes

1. *Run MalwareBytes at LEAST once per month. Once per week is best, if you can spare the time. A full scan takes about 2 hours.*
2. Be sure no other software is open and running, like email or the web browser.
3. Double click the MalwareBytes icon.
4. Click the **UPDATE** tab across the top (see photo below, red circle).

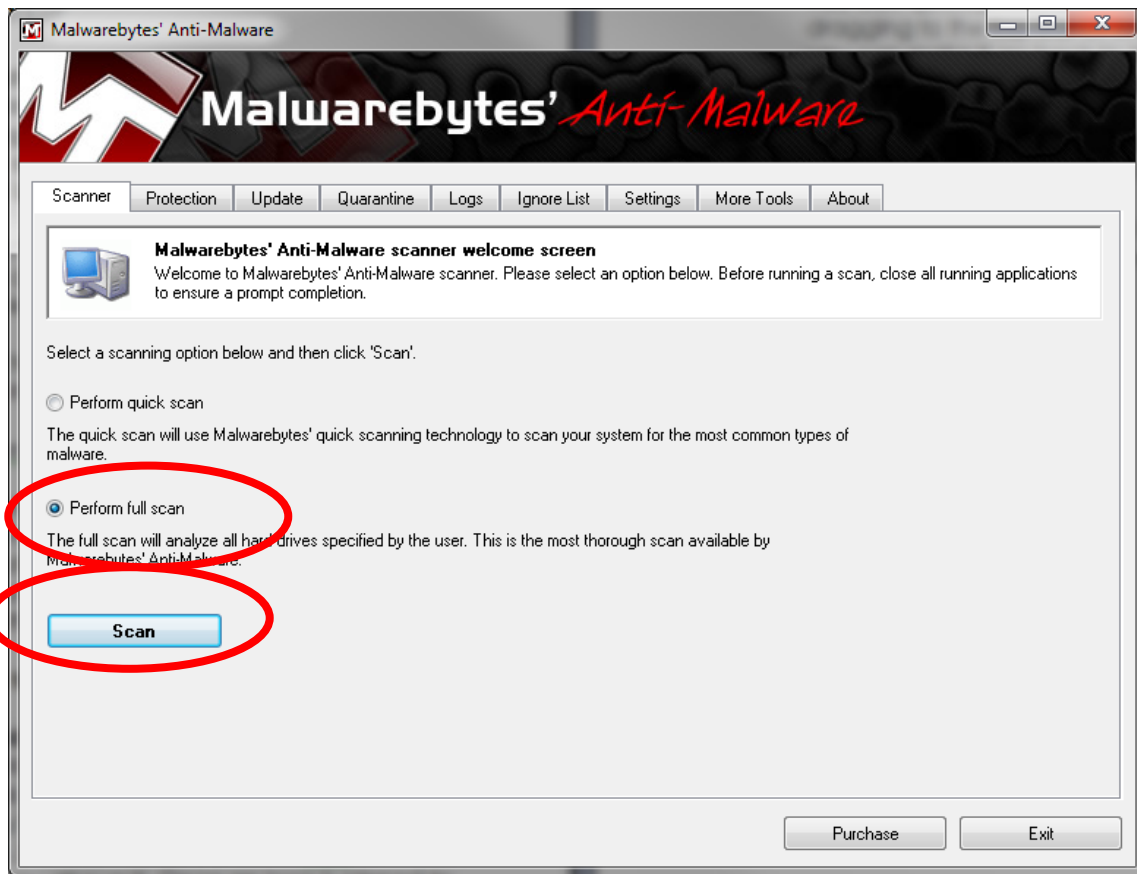


5. Click CHECK FOR UPDATES button once.



6. Wait while the software updates. Click YES if it asks you to install the updates. Click YES if it asks you to restart the computer.
7. When the update is done, click the **SCANNER tab** across the top (to the left of the UPDATE TAB).

8. Click to put a **dot** next to "**PERFORM A FULL SCAN**".



9. Click the **SCAN** button.
10. The scan will begin. The scan will take between 1 and 2 hours. Please do not work on your computer while scanning.
11. When done, It will give you a window with results. If no threats were found, HOORAY! Click OK, then close MalwareBytes with the red "x", top right.
12. If it did find threats, you will have to follow the on-screen instructions, as each result will vary according to what it found. I would also recommend that you consult Action One Computers (498-2855) about having a professional scan performed to thoroughly disinfect the computer.
